

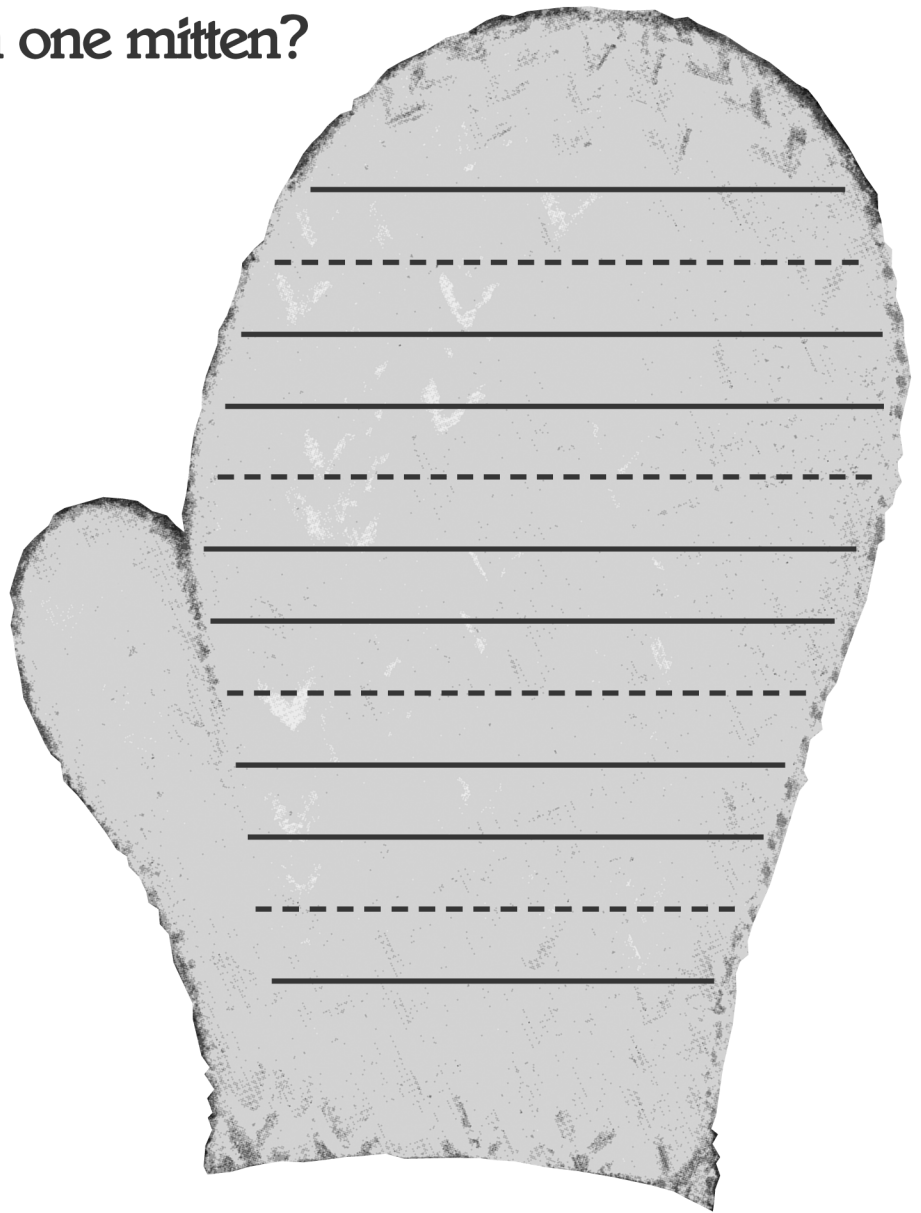
The **one mitten** Imagination Challenge
